

The most characteristic site of the Summer Palace is the Long Corridor which extends more than 700 metres and is lined with scenes from Chinese history and mythology. ### Evening Tour & Reception Capital Museum

Monday, 14 May 2007

The permanent "Brief History of Beijing" exhibition traces Beijing's 3,000-year history with a display of more than 1,000 objects.

The exhibition presents the city's history in six sections: the development of an organized community from ancient settlements; historical remains of the former cities of Yan and Ji; gradual development as an important northern center; the capital of half of China during the Liao and Jin dynasties; the world renowned Yuan Dynasty capital of Dadu; and the political center of the Ming and Qing dynasties.

## Closing Reception & Dinner Great Hall of the People

Tuesday, 15 May 2007

The Great Hall of the People is located on the west side of the Tianammen Square in Beijing. Housing the National People's Congress, it was completed in 1959. The shape of the building is representation of the Chinese character for "mountain" and it stretches 336 meters from south to north and 206 meters from east to west with a total coverage area of 15 acres. There are more than 30 halts named after Chinese provinces and decorated in appropriate regional styles. 

degrees Celsius (59-77 degrees Fahrenheit) and sporadic rain showers.


#### TRANSPORTATION

Participants should arrange their own transportation from the airport to the hotel. Private car pick-up can be arranged by the hotel for a fee depending on the type of car. China World Hotel is 23 kilometers from the airport and a one-way taxi ride costs around RMB 120 including express toll. Huadu Hotel is 18 kilometers away from the airport and a one-way taxi ride costs around RMB 70 including express toll. Please find attached map for your reference.

Transportation between hotels and venues will be served only for the official hotels: China World Hotel and Huadu Hotel.


